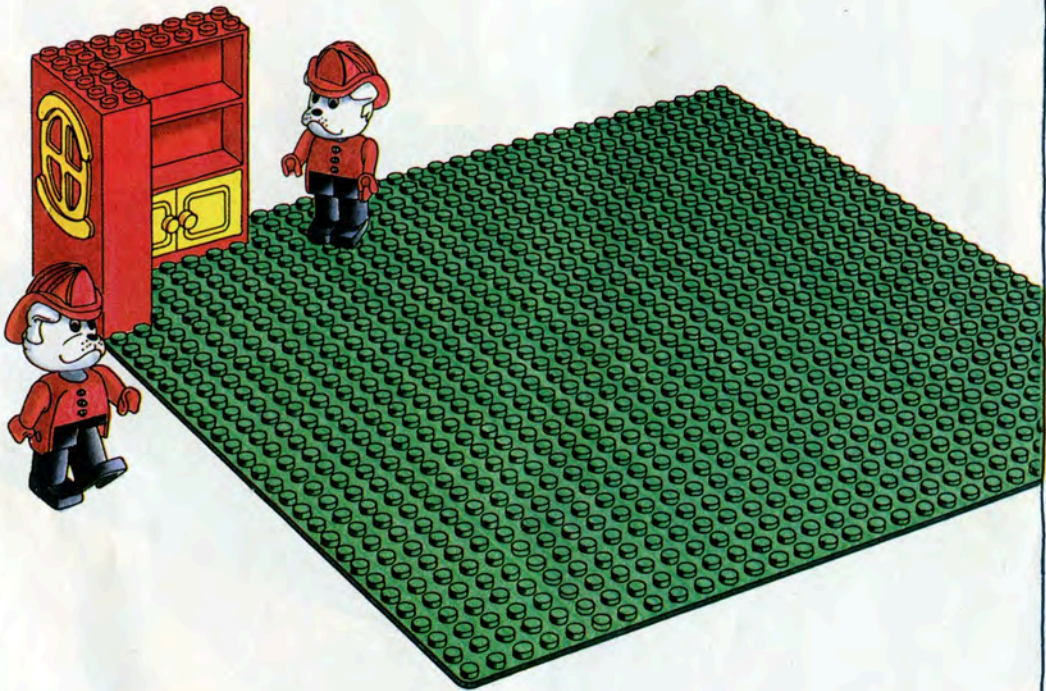

“Build it”, he told his firemen. They set up a windowed wall in the corner of the plate.

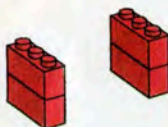
“There must be a place to put our hats”, said the Chief.

The firemen put up a side wall with a cupboard.

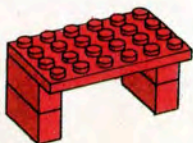

The Chief said, "Let's make an office here." Two small bricks were laid down, each man added another.

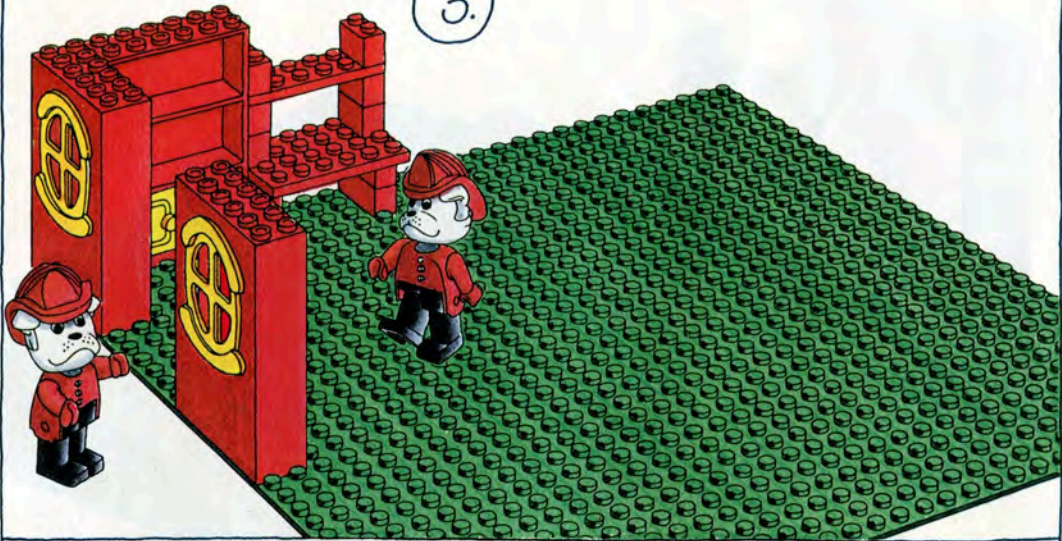
CLIK, CLIK. Then a flat table top snapped into place.

Four small bricks were built over that - two on each side. A plate was used for a shelf.

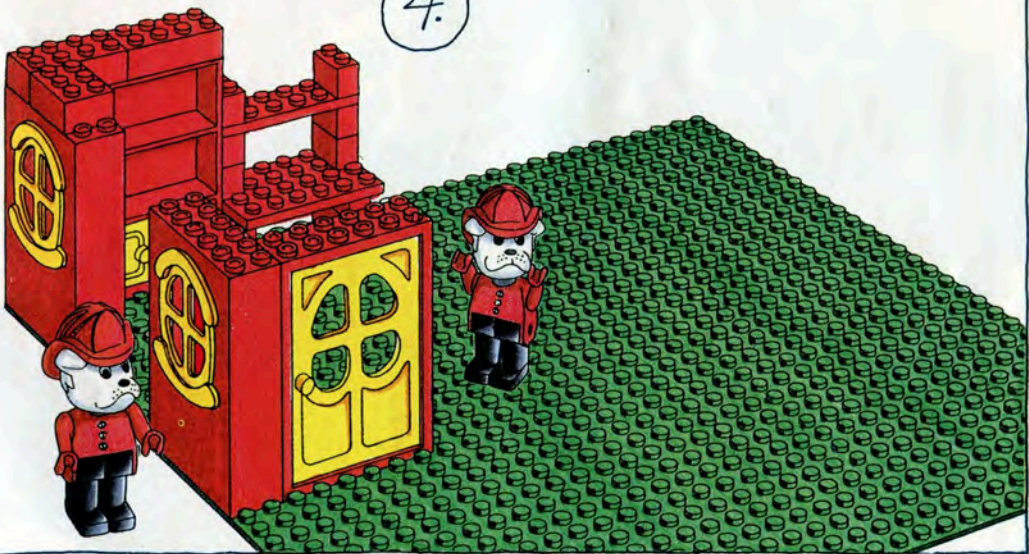
Two small bricks went on top.

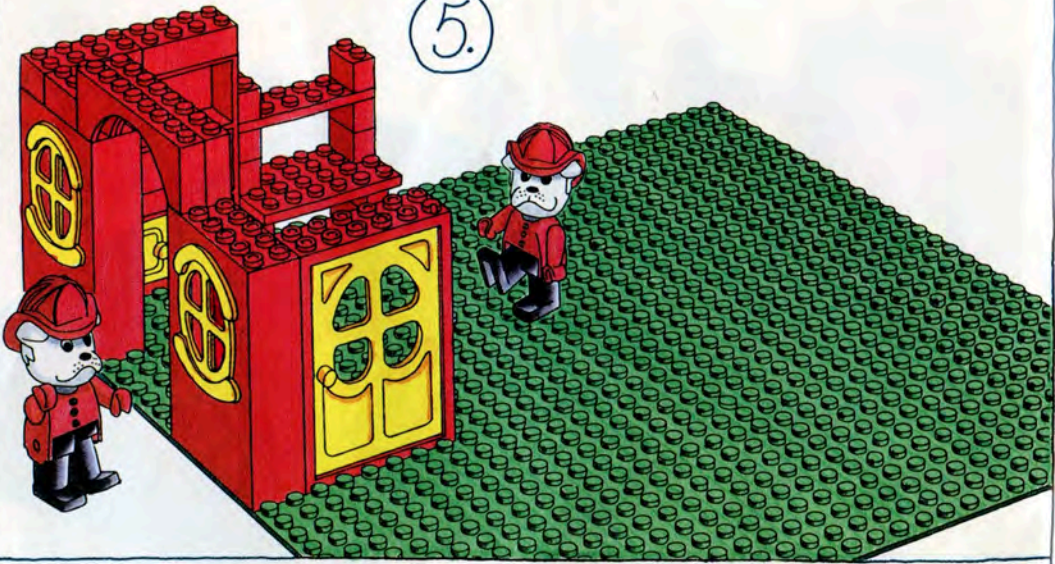

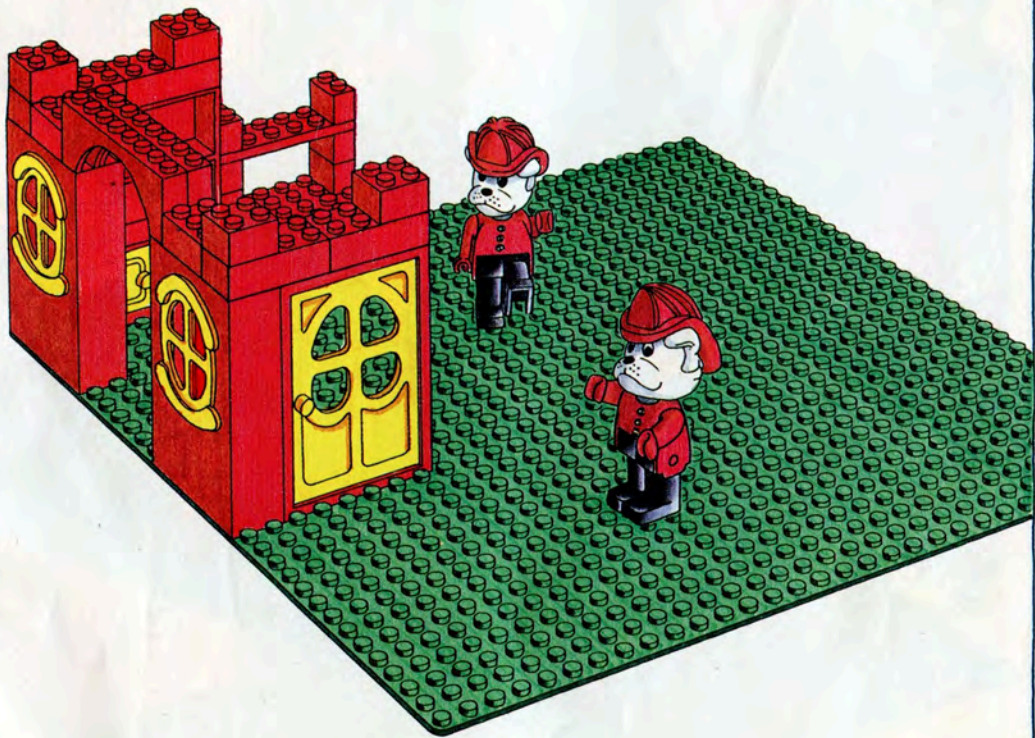

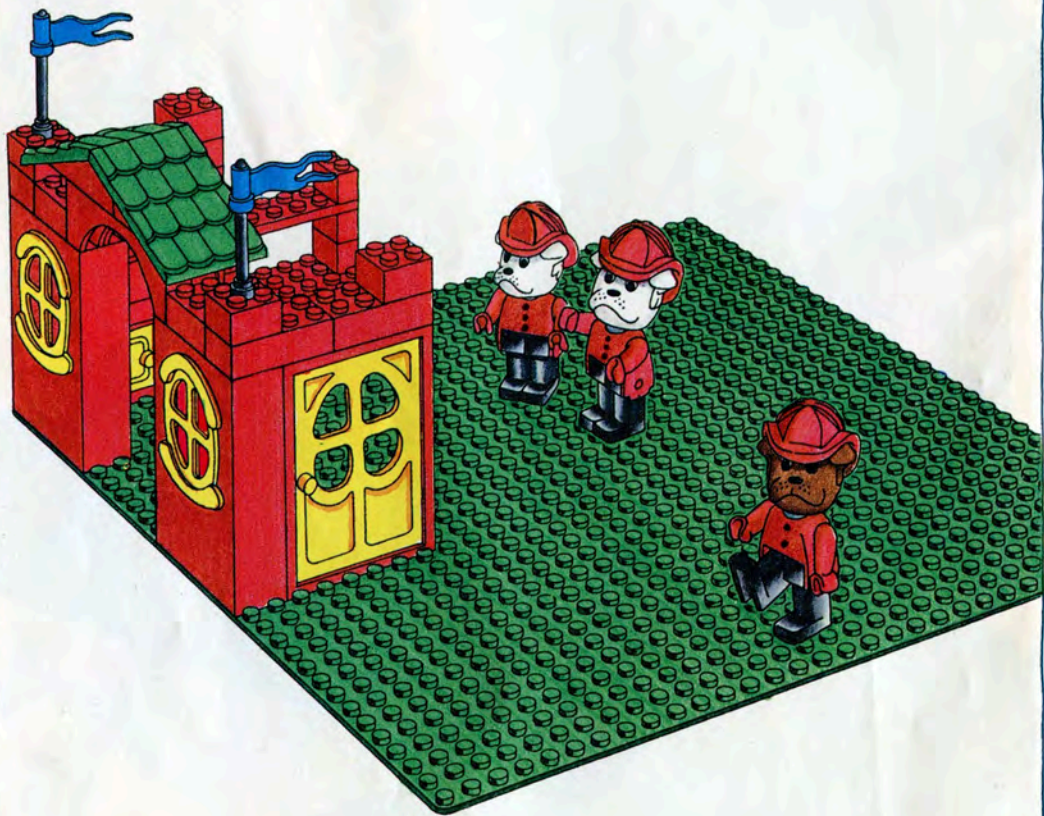
They stretched two arches across the windowed walls.

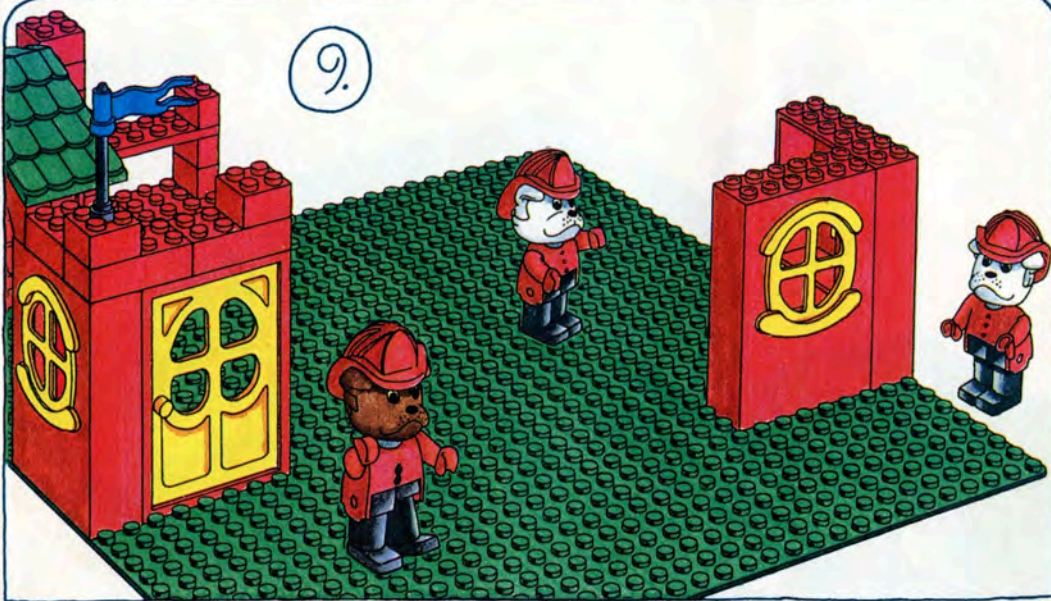
The firemen put a square red brick on each corner.

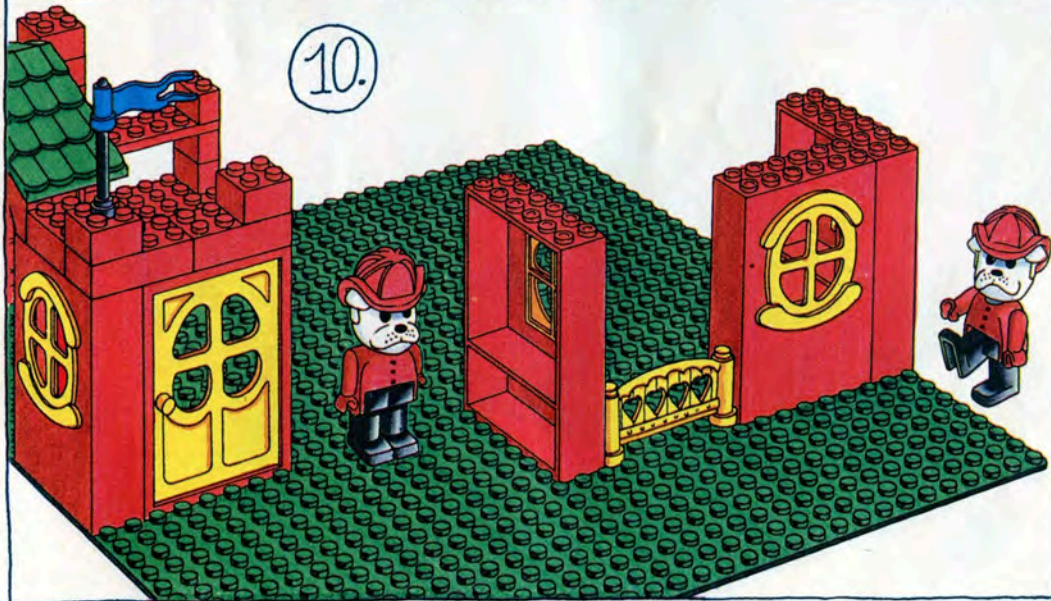


The two green roofs locked onto the arch.

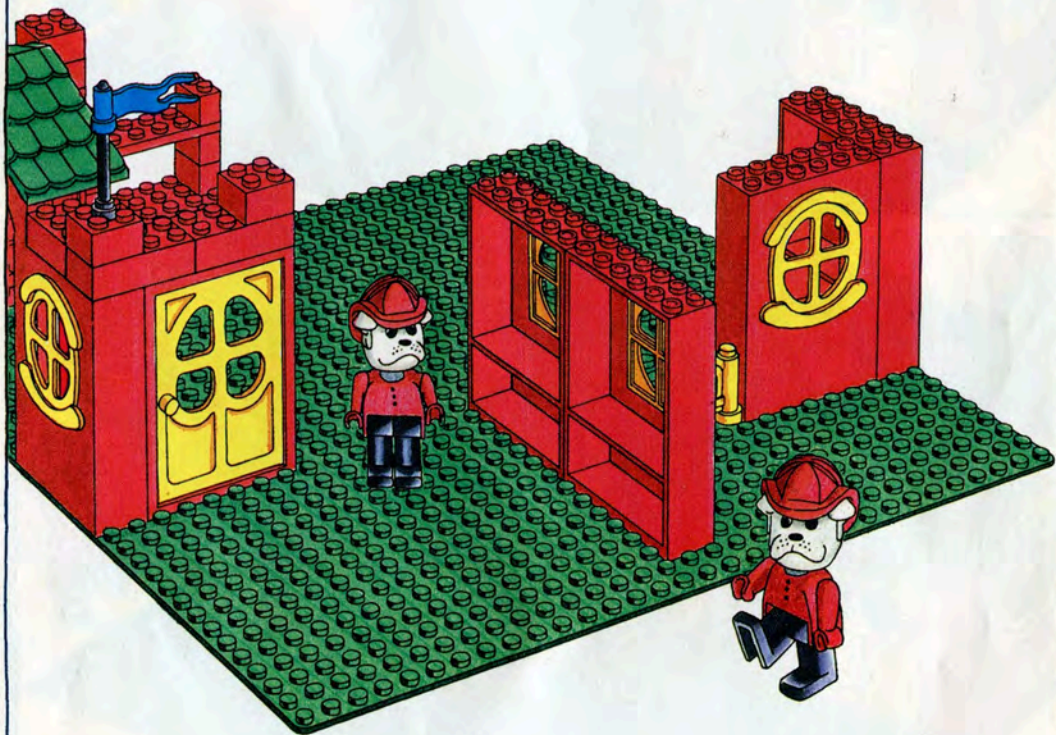


On the other side of the base plate, eight knobs from the corner, two more windowed walls were built, making a corner.

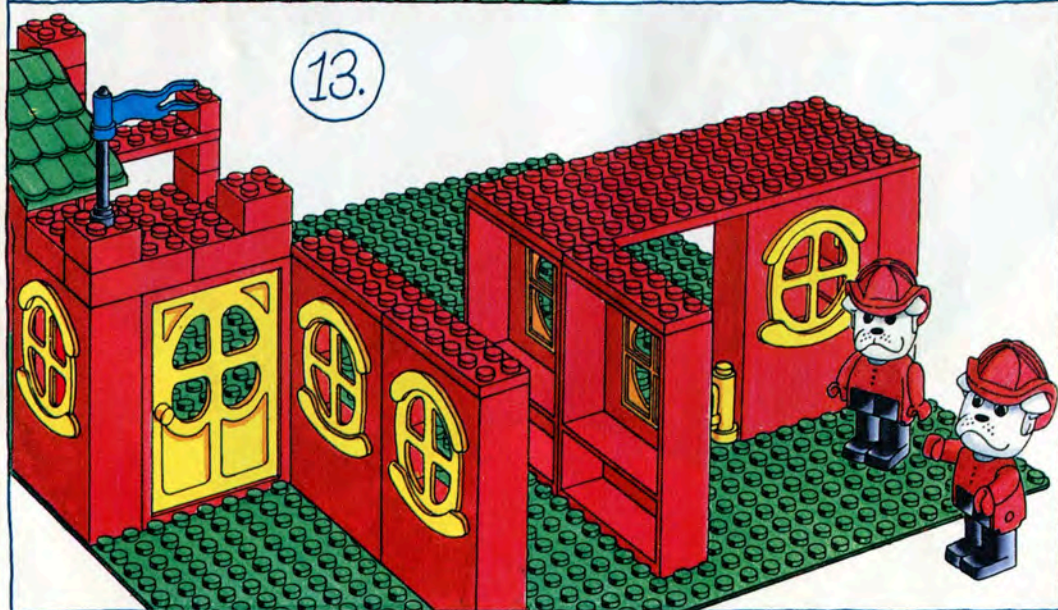
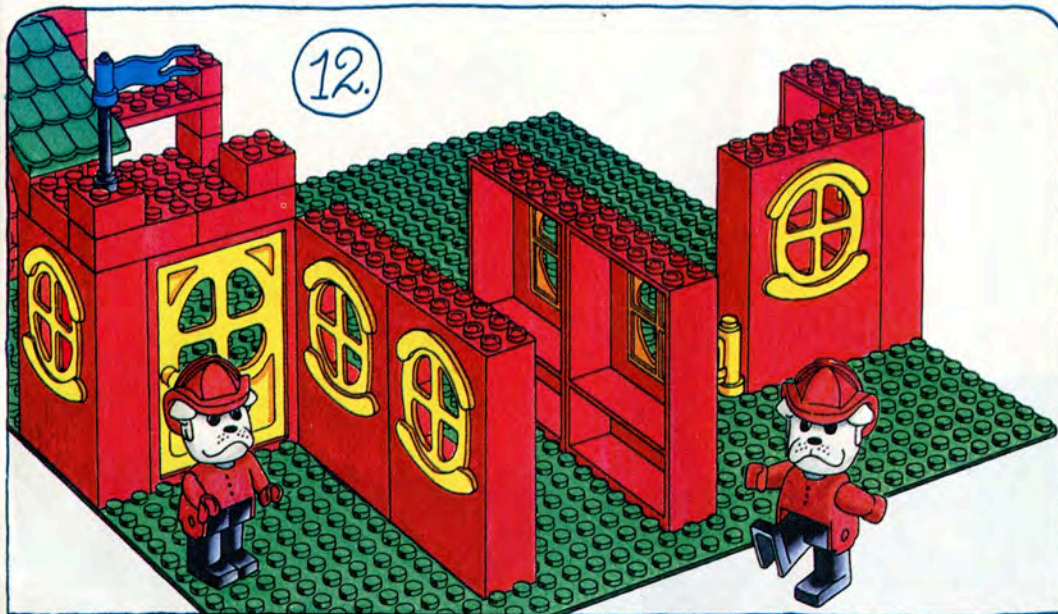
A yellow fence was put in place with a CLICK next to the windowed wall.

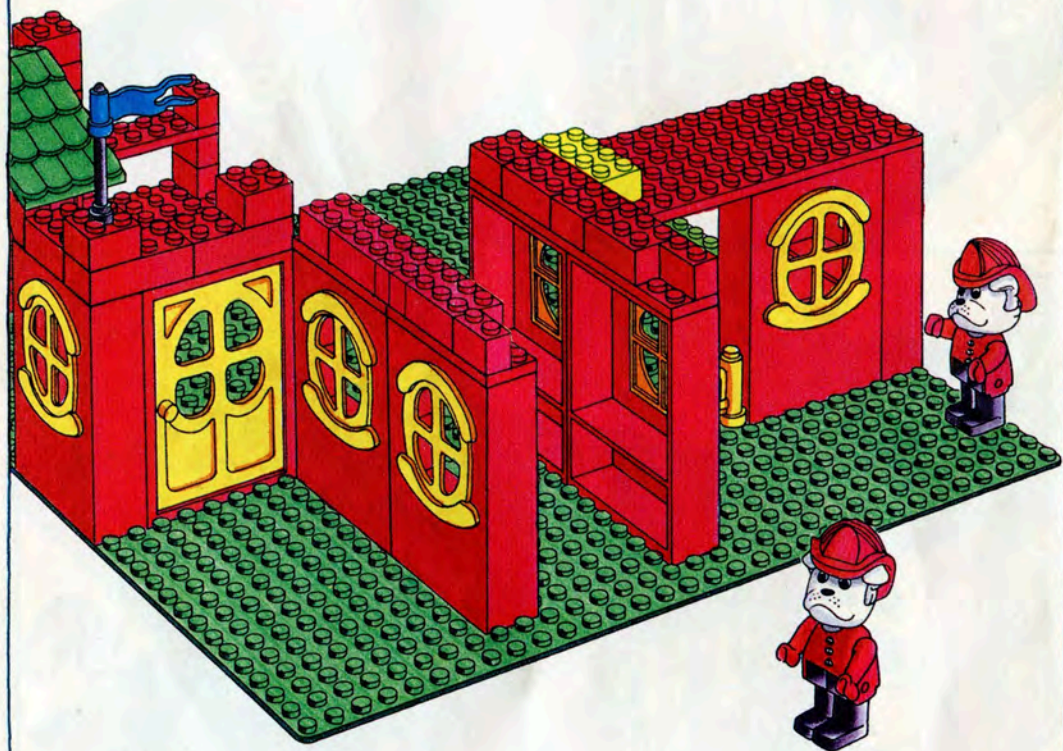


The firemen put a second new wall alongside the first.

They stacked four bricks on the garage walls. They added a small brick on the front corner.

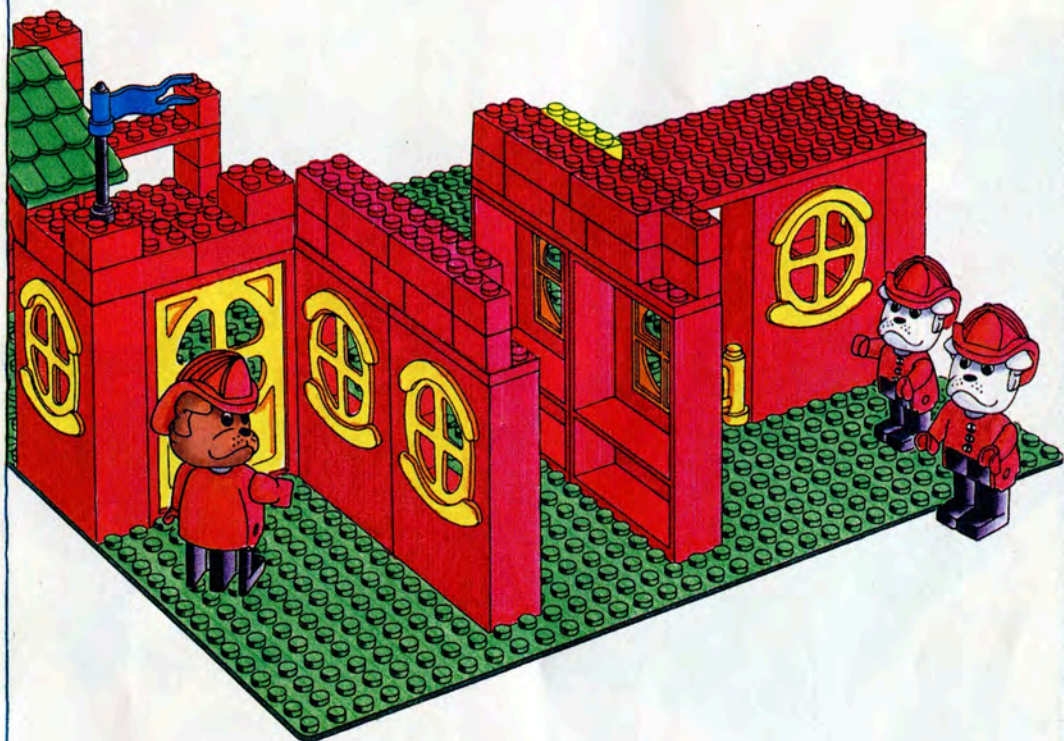
On the back, they added a yellow brick to make the first step.

They put them down in order, first one, then the other.

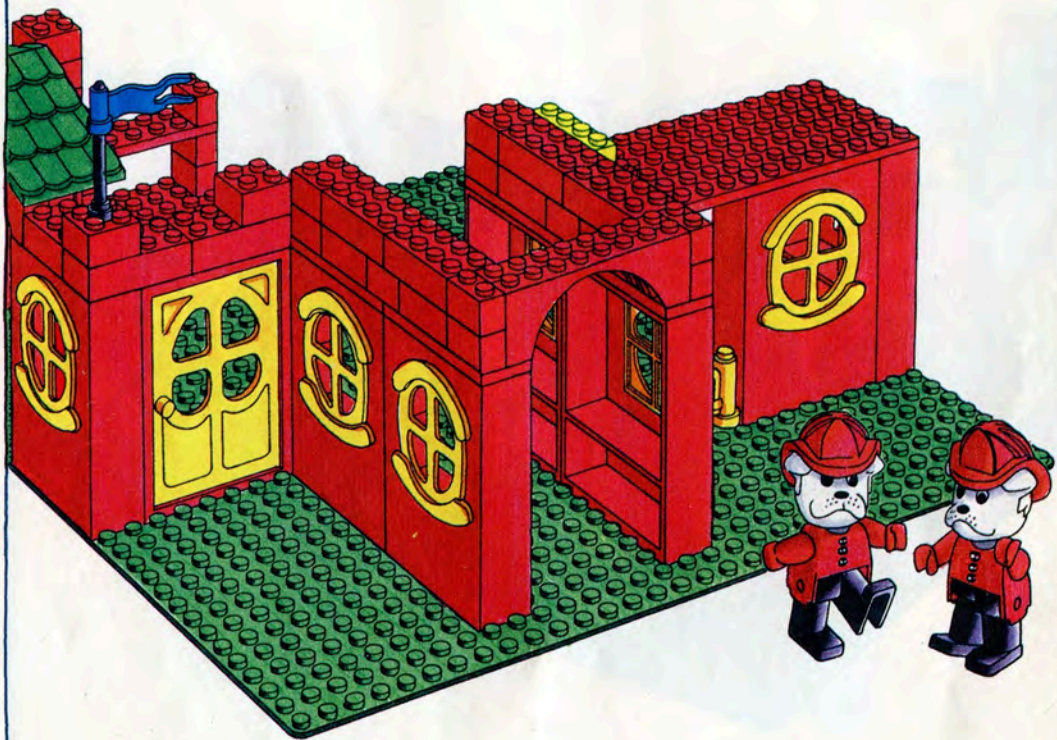
A small brick went on this corner too.

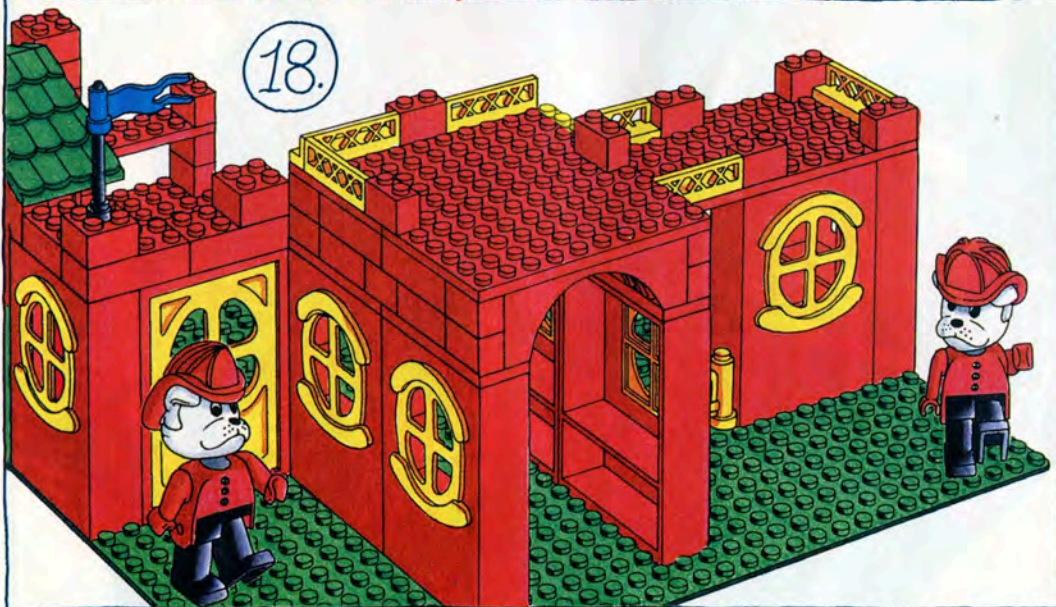
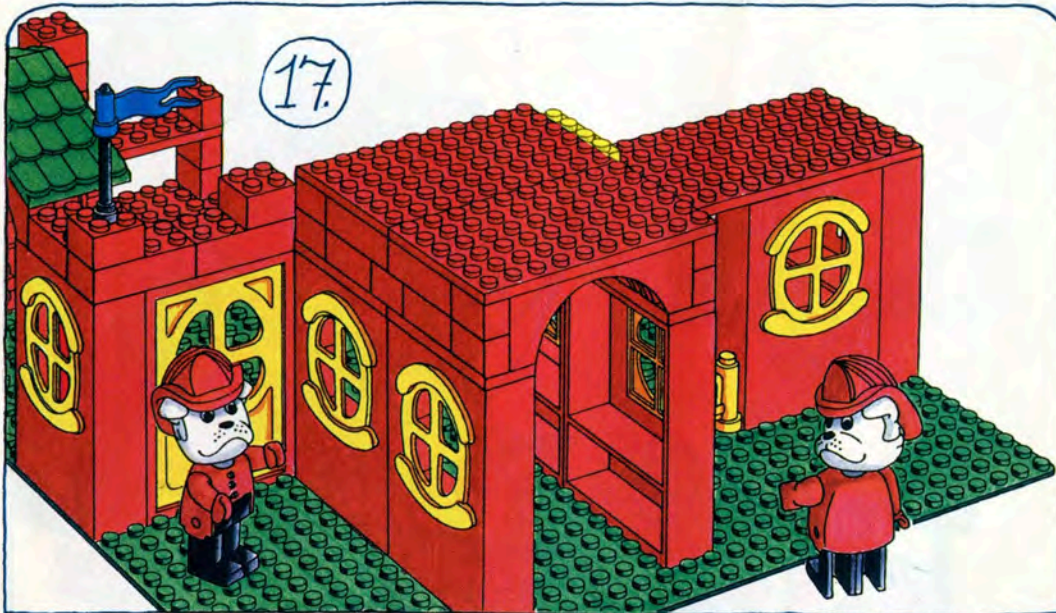


Together they built a second row, just like the first.

"They fit good and tight", the firemen were pleased.

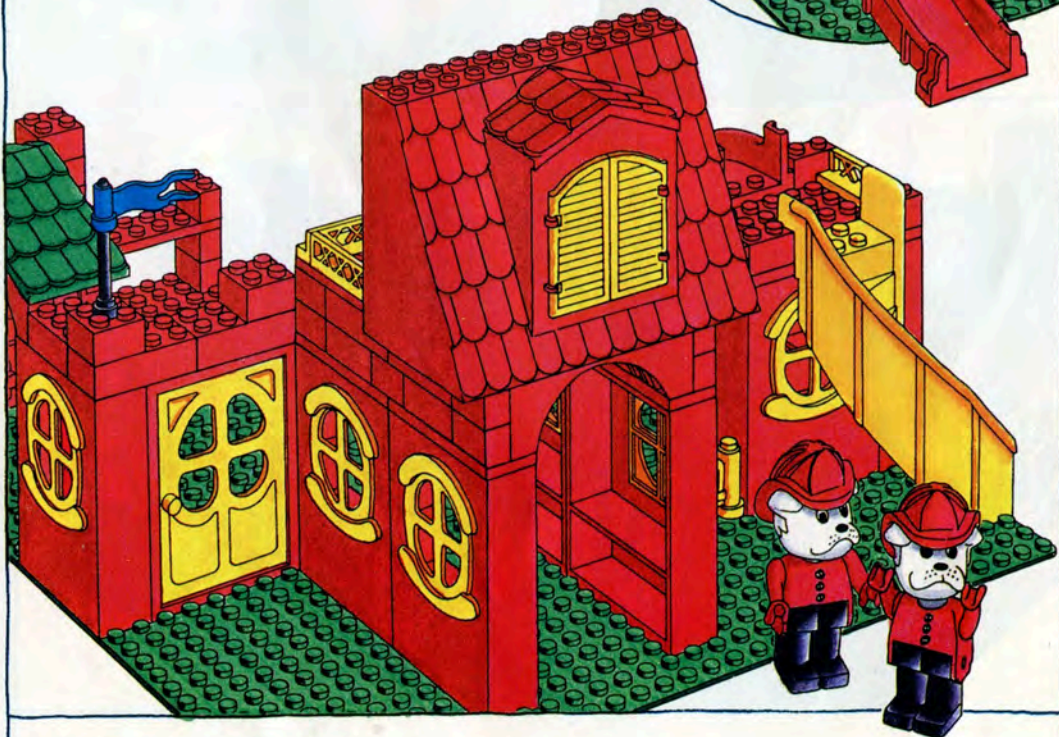
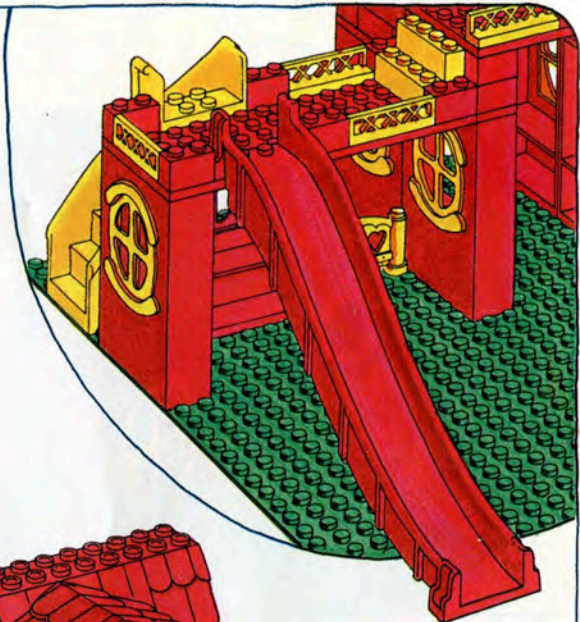


Two big plates went over it all.

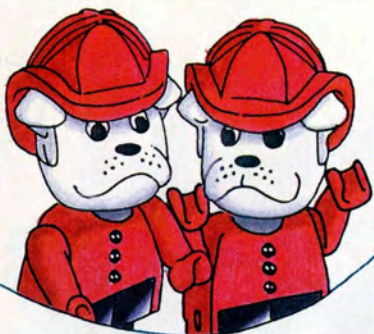
Now, they put up six fence pieces, three on the garage plus three near the stairs.

"Wouldn't want the Chief to fall down", the firemen agreed.

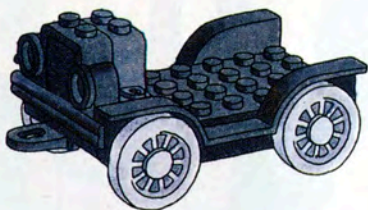
In between each fence piece went a small brick.



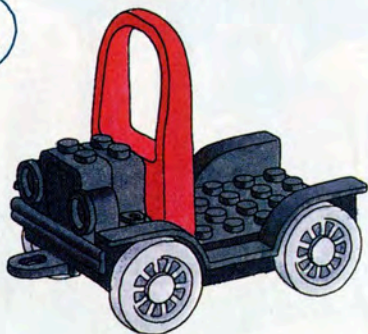
The big red roof piece was locked snugly into place.

Then they put up a slide so that they could get down quickly, if necessary.



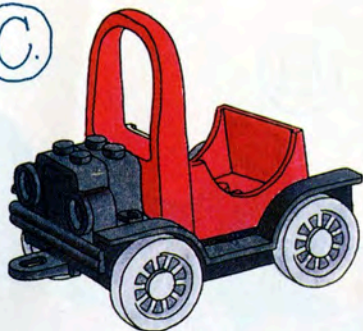

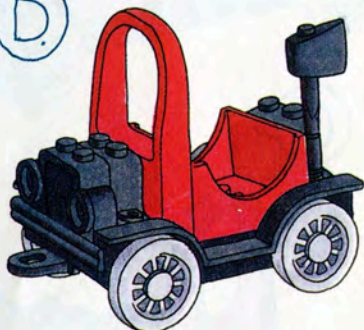

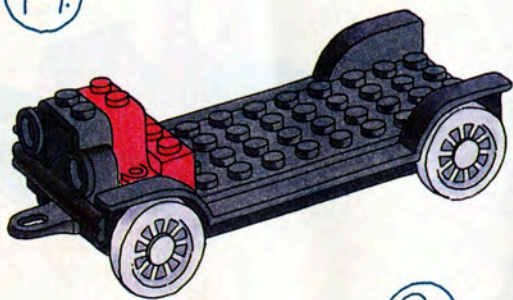
A: Knowing the Chief would want his own car, the firemen began to build. Each one put half the headlight onto the front and the black engine.

B: They fixed the windscreen into place.

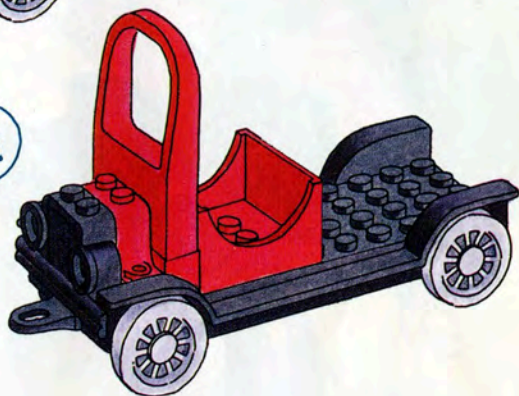
C: CLICK! They made sure Chief Bartie's seat was comfortable.

D: They put a special brick like the engine behind the seat and attached his sharp hatchet very carefully.

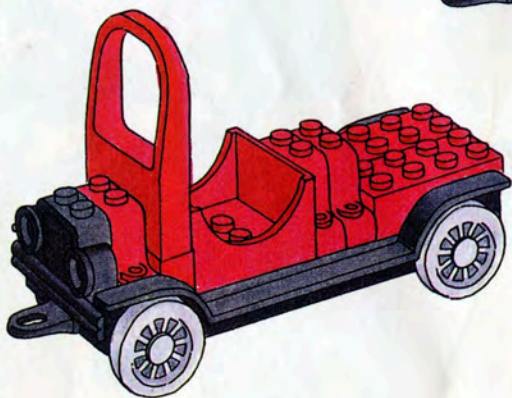

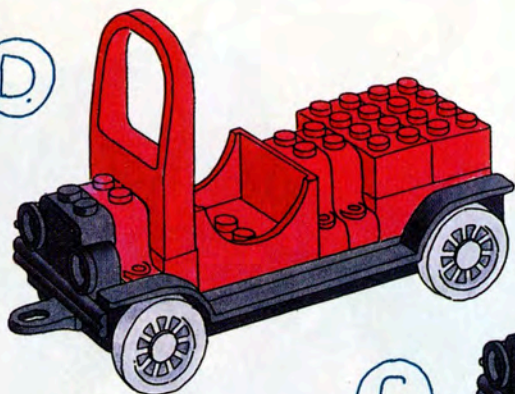

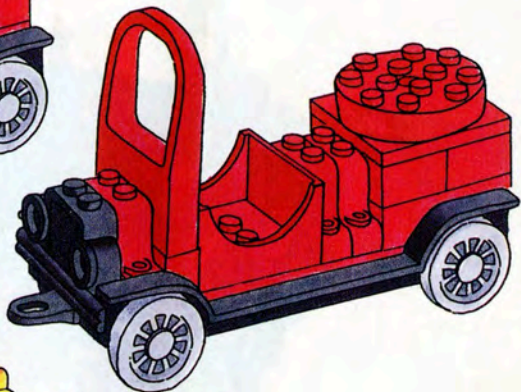
"Let's get that fire engine built in a hurry. We may need it sooner than we think", barked the Chief.

- C: They put two special red pieces like the engine behind the seat and clicked two bricks onto the back. 1-2!

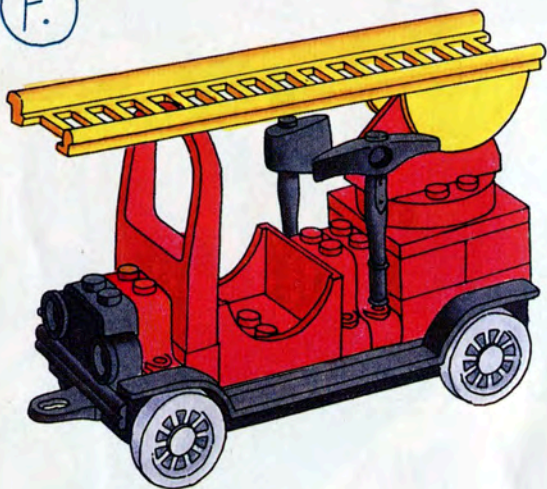

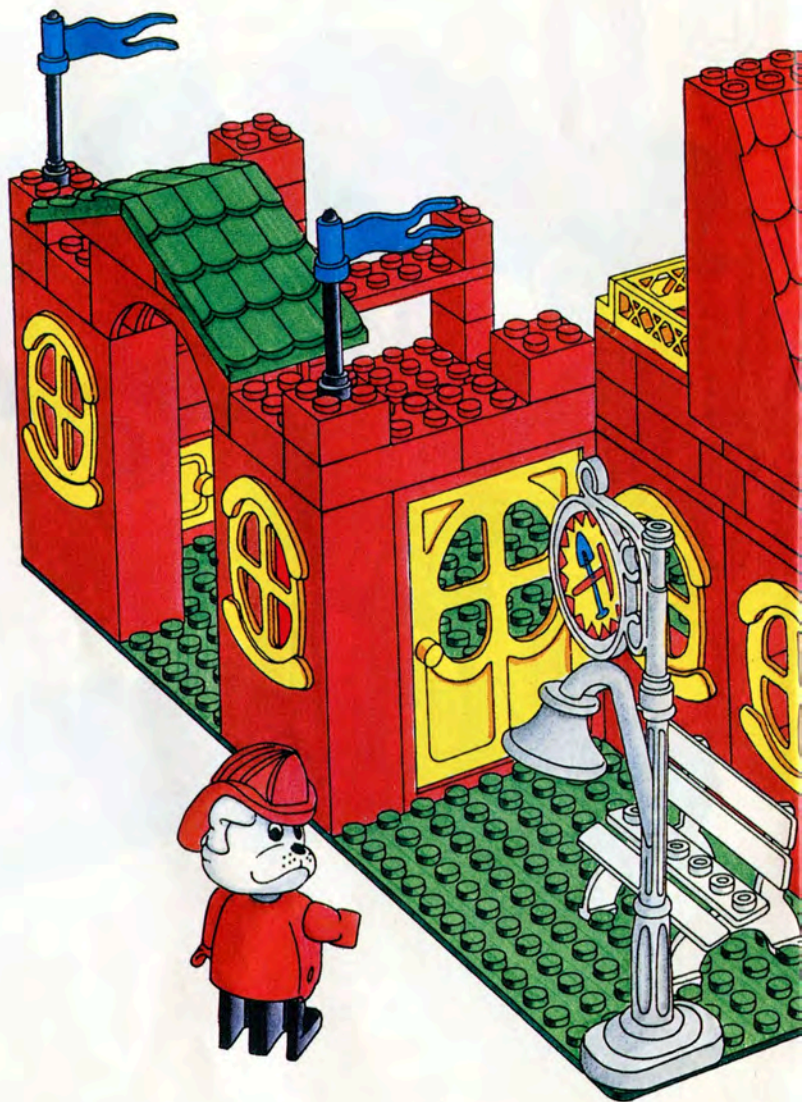

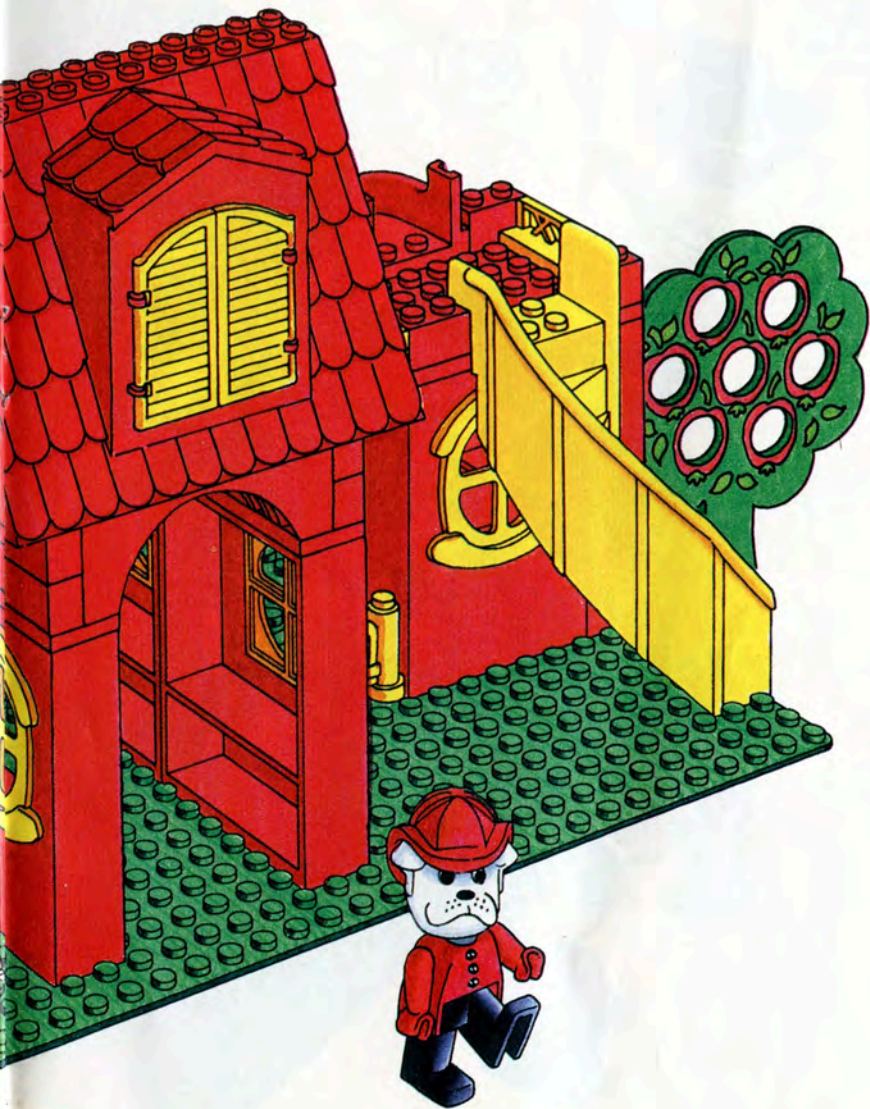
D: Two more bricks clicked on top, crosswise. 3-4!

E: The turntable went over the four bricks.

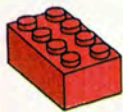
F: They attached the ladder. Finally, a pick axe and hatchet were put on the truck.



The firemen put out a bench, a lamp-post, a sign and a tree.



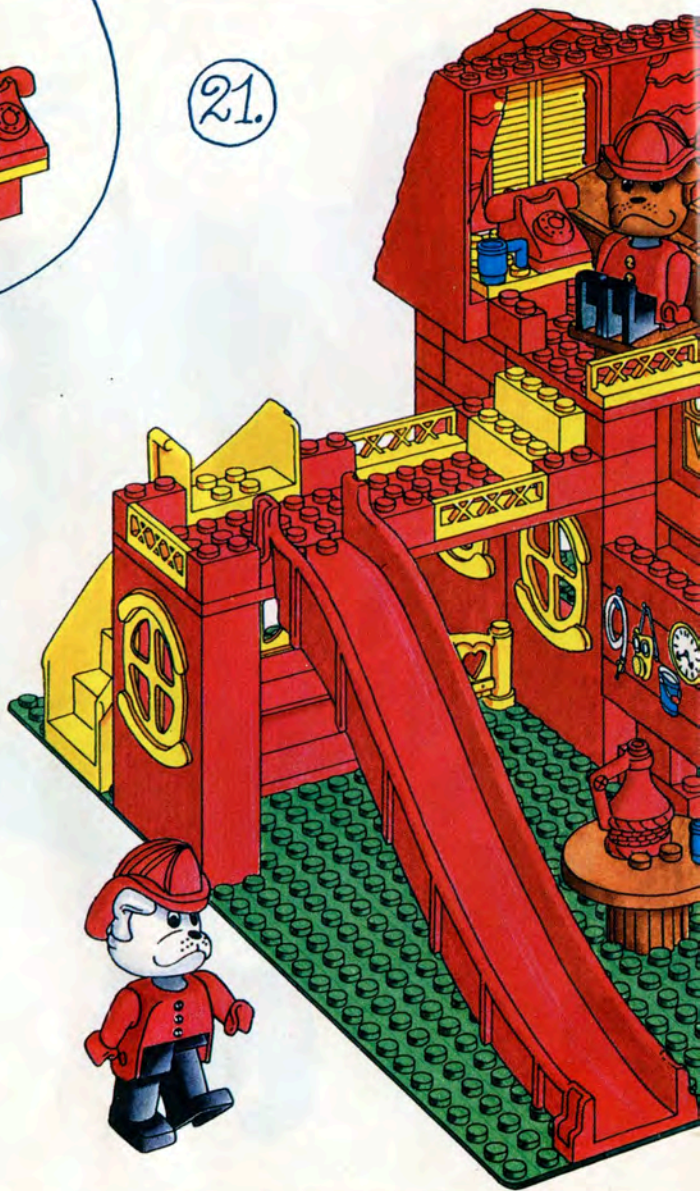

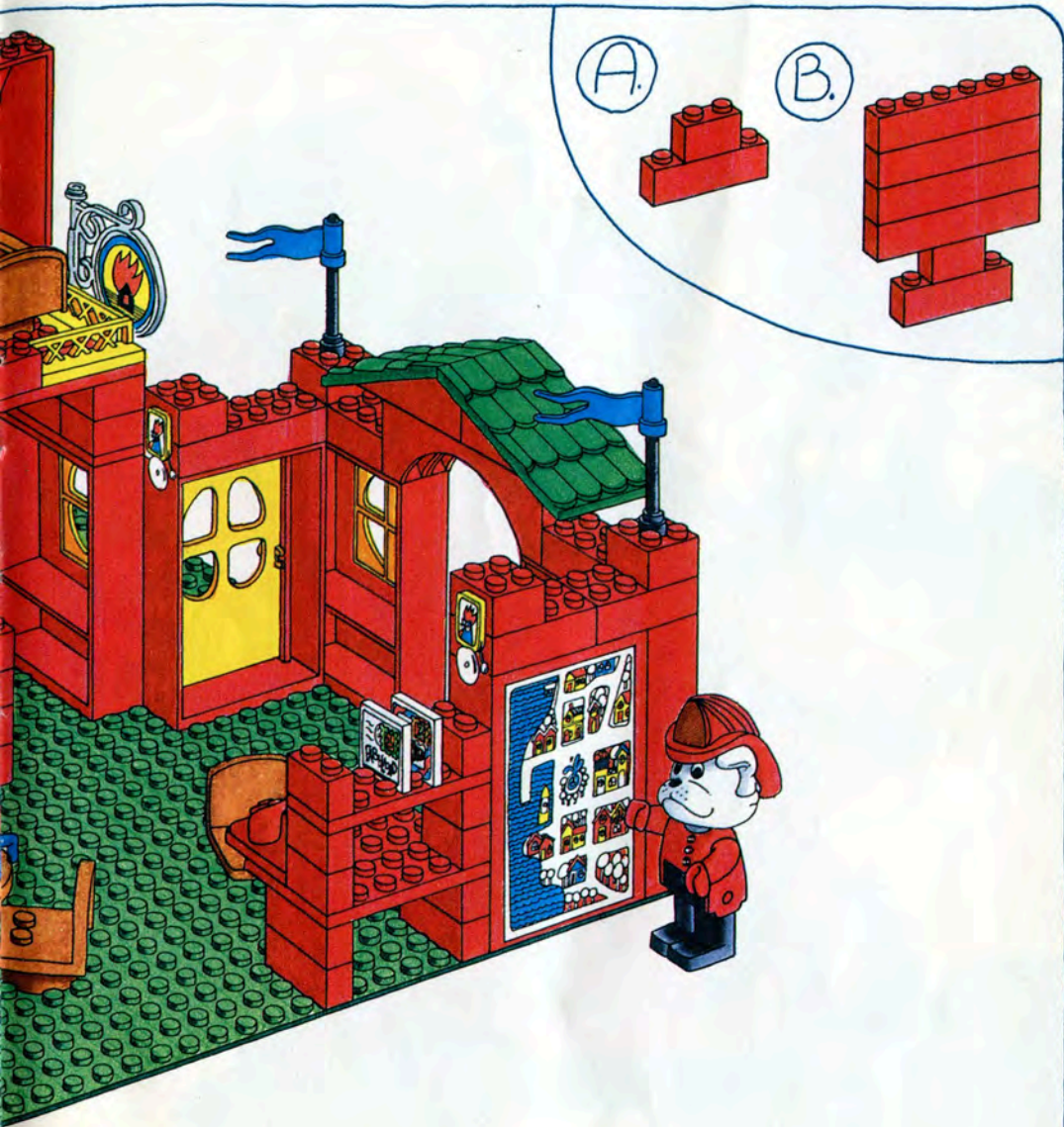

They all raced towards the smoke.



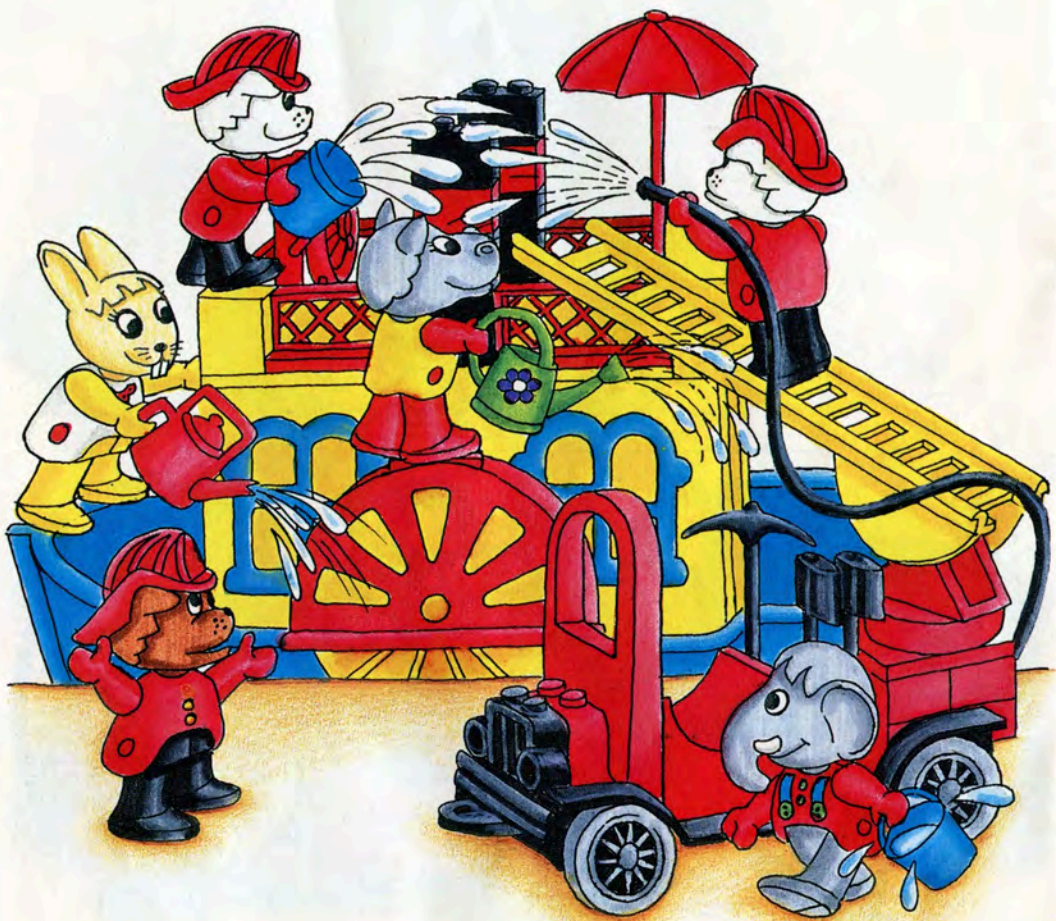
Everyone came running with buckets and jars.

TOOT! TOOT!

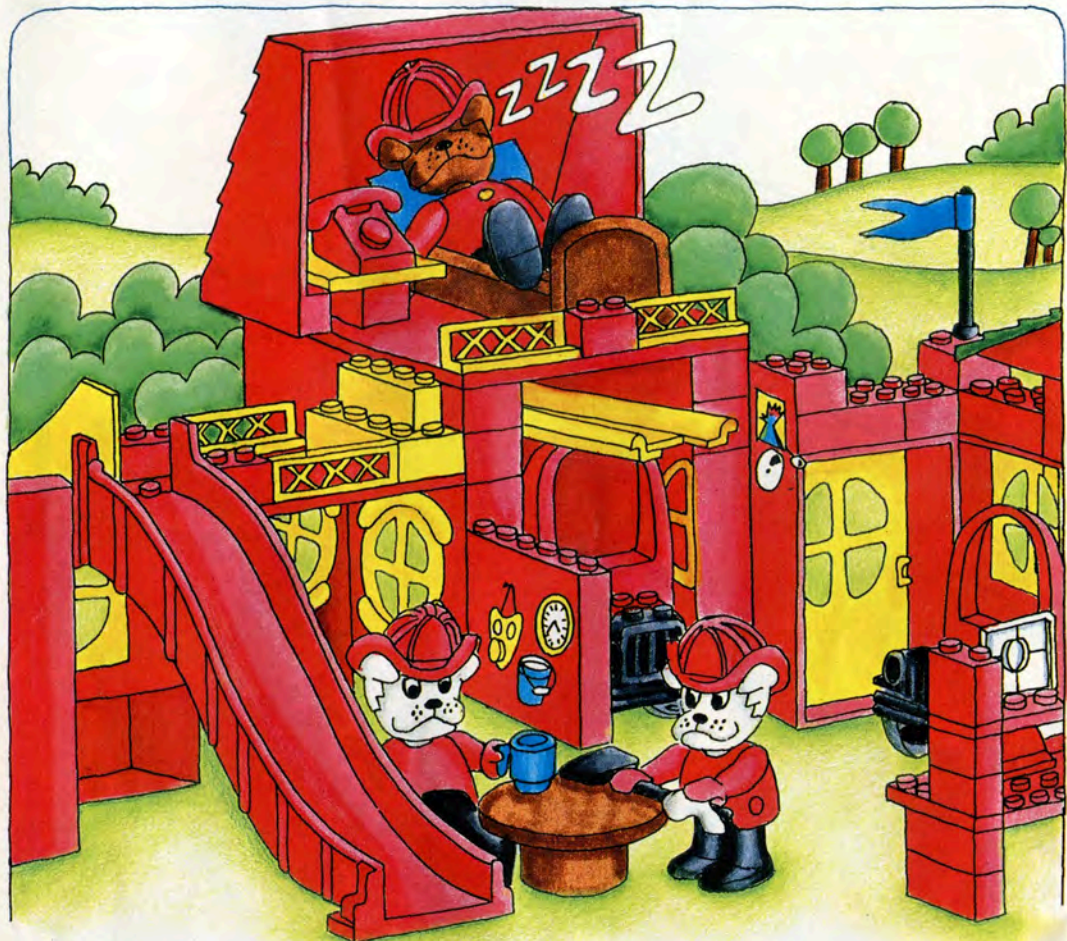


"I feel foolish", said Bonnie.

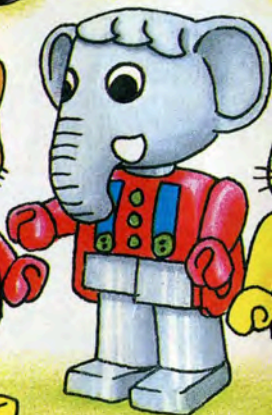

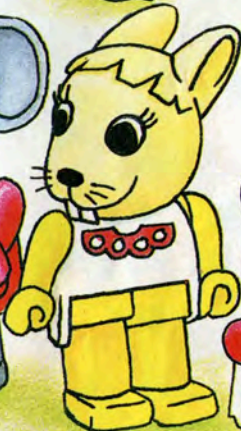
