Edward Elephant is a worrier. He's afraid the merry-go-round isn't strong enough to hold a big elephant.

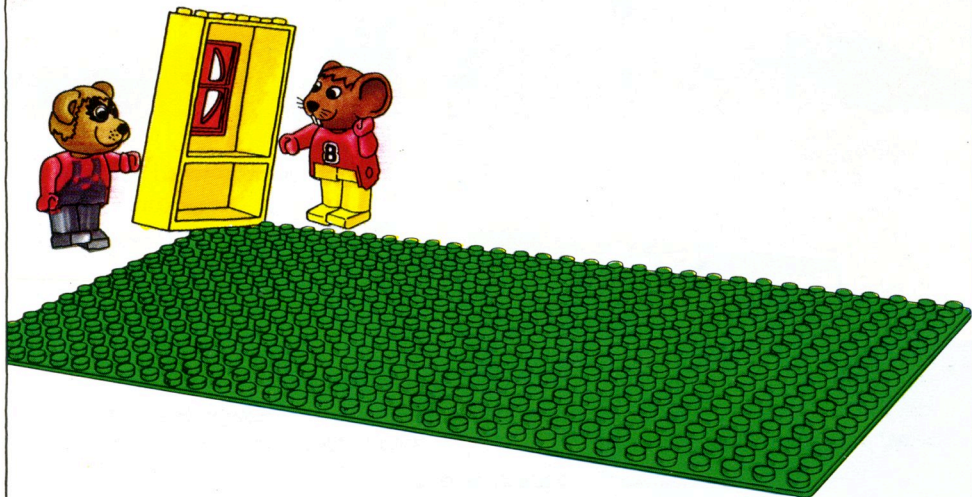
"FABULAND® needs a merry-go-round,"

"Help me build one, Max. You're very clever."

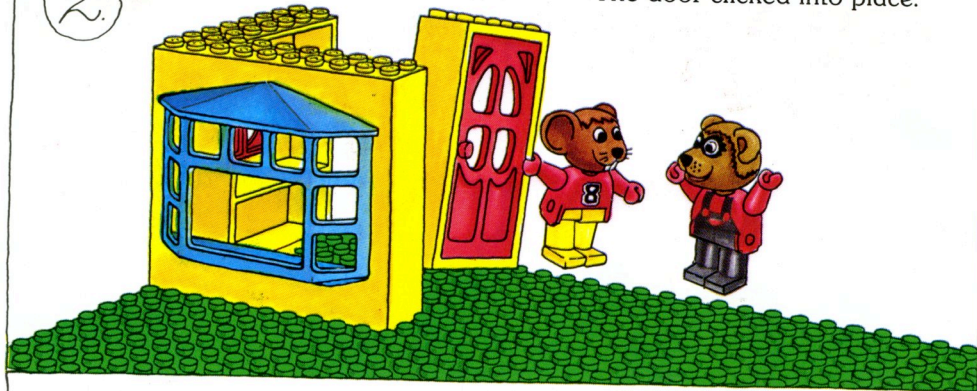
They began by snapping a window-wall to the base plate.

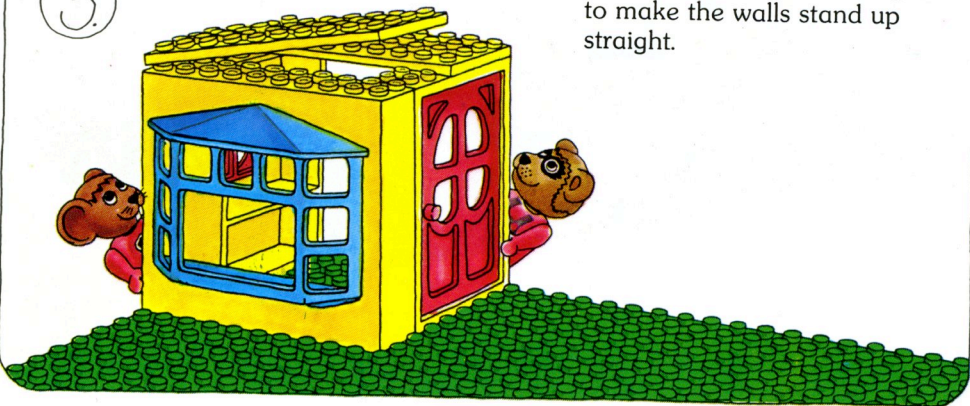

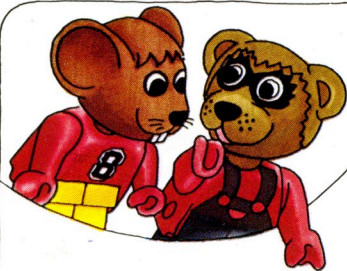
Next came the front wall

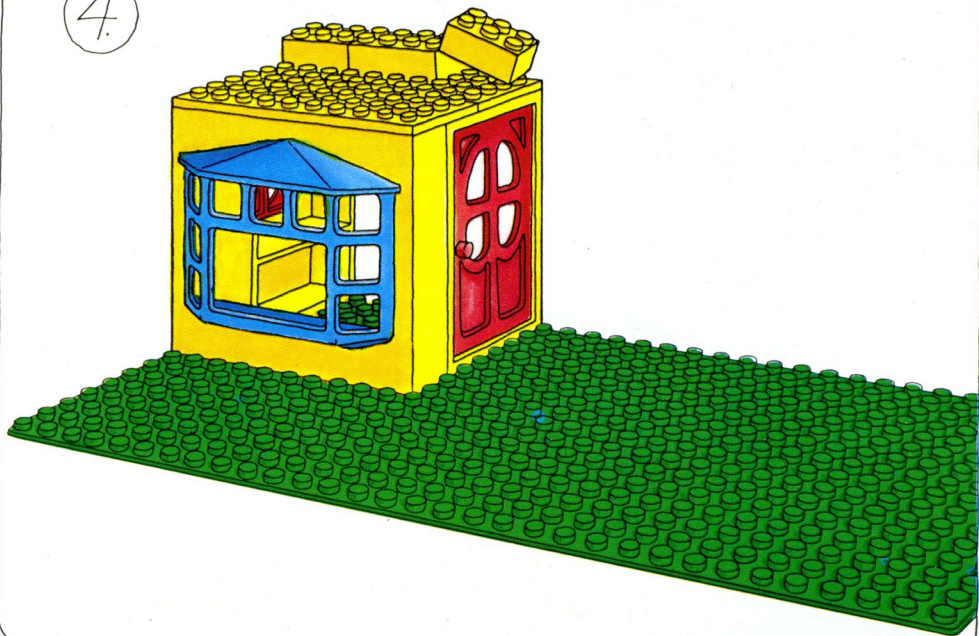
Roof plates are fixed on tight

straight.





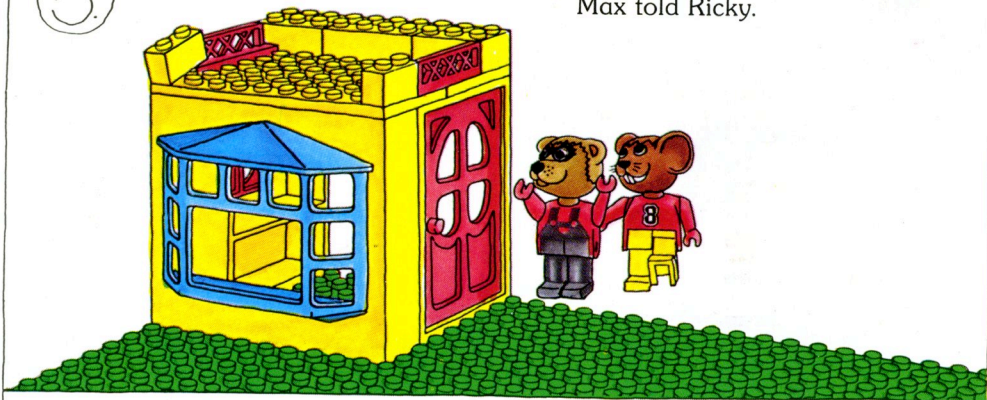
SNAP! CLICK! Bricks went on top

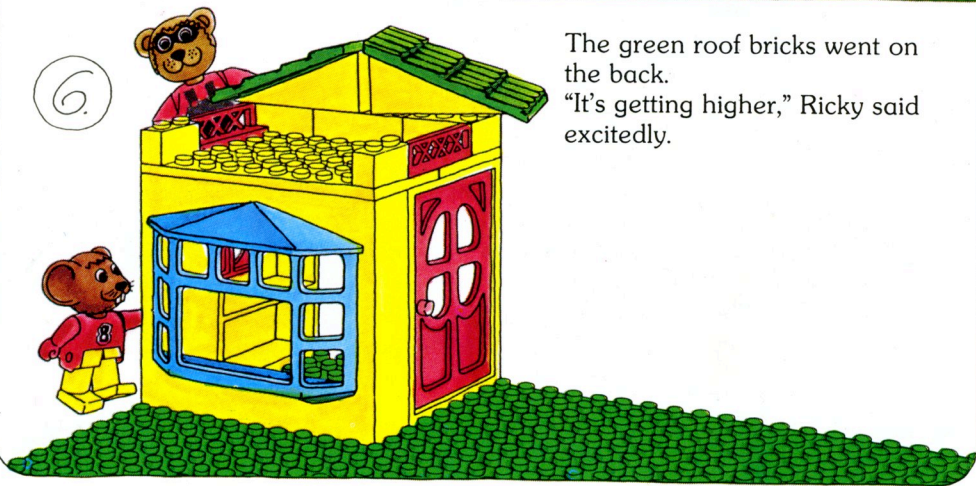

Max told Ricky.

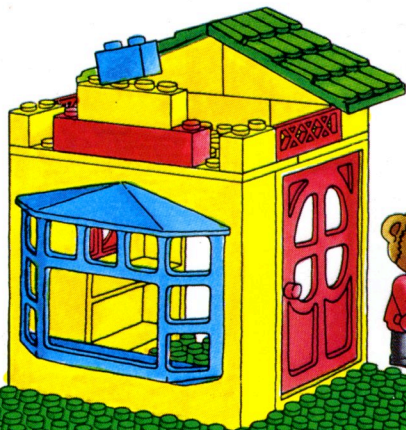

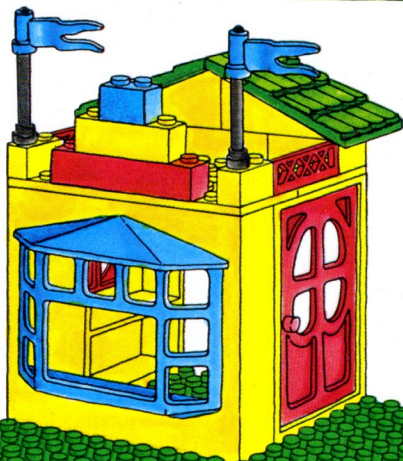


The Three bricks, the red, the yellow and the blue were put in place.

But, of course, the job wasn't done yet.



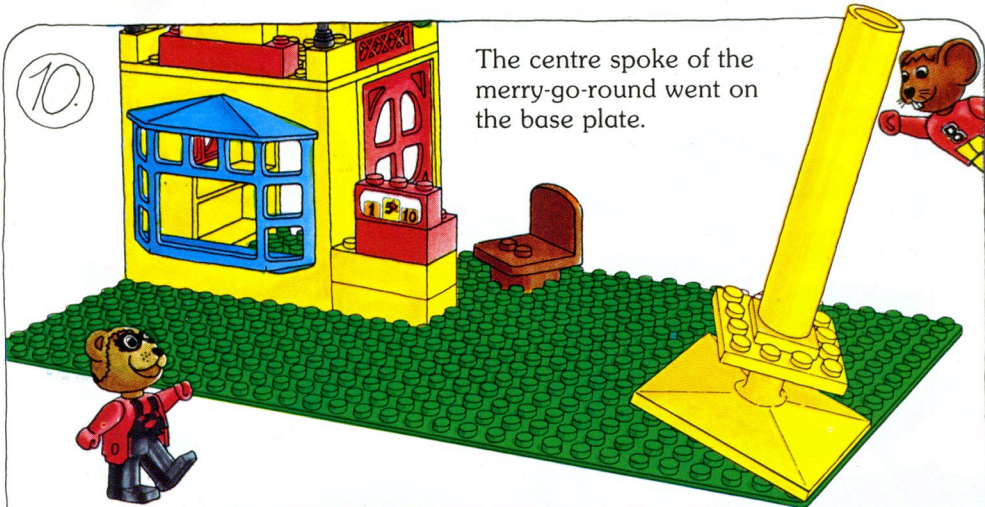
Ricky still needed a ticket counter.

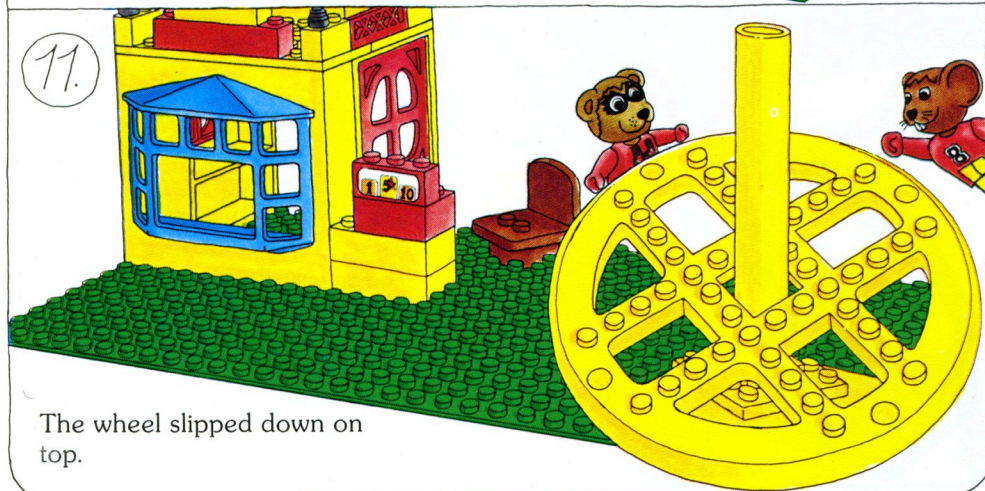

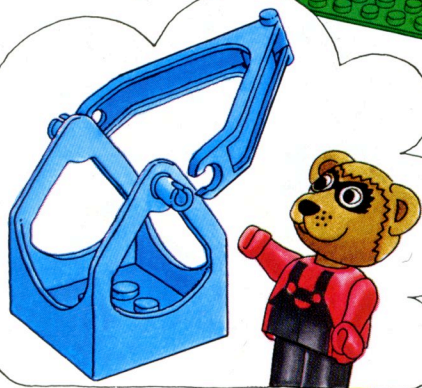
The centre spoke of the merry-go-round went on the base plate.

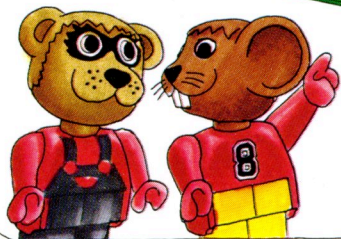
The wheel slipped down on top.

indeed.

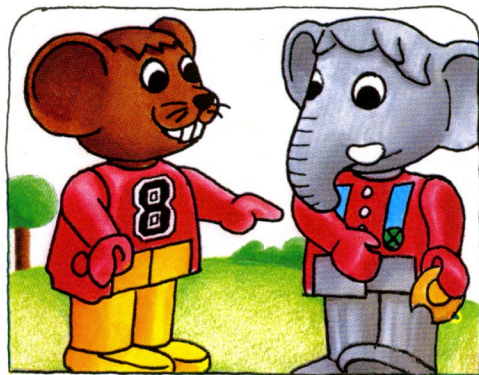

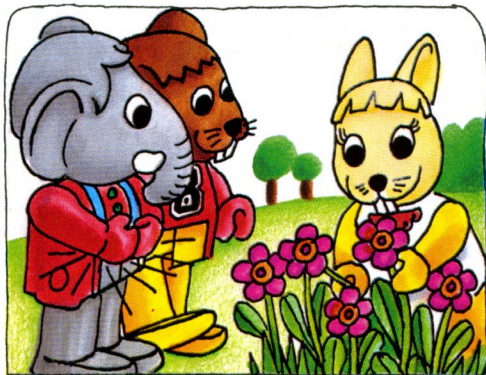
The following pages features a small FABULAND® story which may show figures and buildings not included in the box.

"Fantastic," Edward agreed, reaching for another piece of cake.

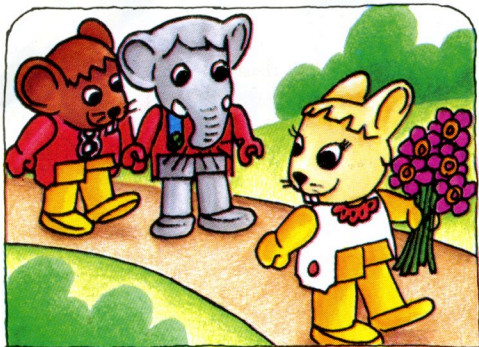


Max Mouse joined them. "Don't eat so much if you're going on the merry-go-round. You could get sick."

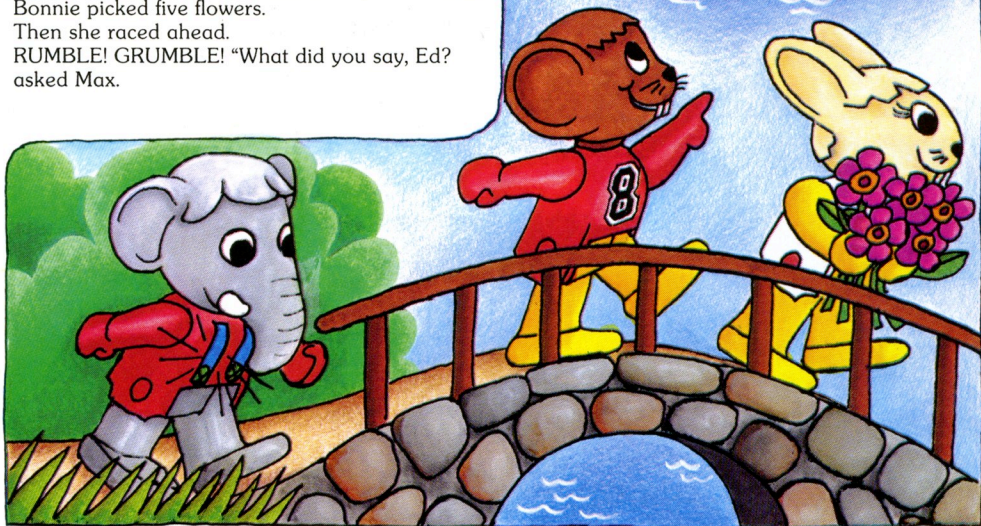


"Not me," said Edward just as his tummy started to rumble.

asked Max.



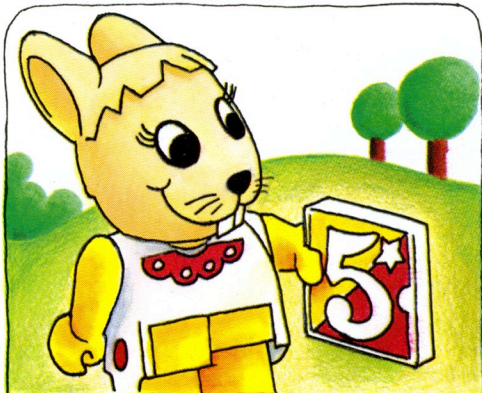
TOOT! TOOT! drowned out that tummy. "There sails Captain Wally and his Paddle Steamer!"
Max pointed, turning around.



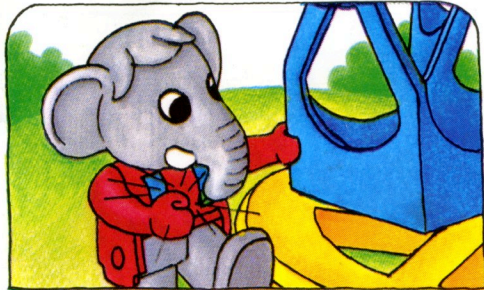
Ricky Raccoon rushed out to meet them. "How many tickets, folks? You're going to love this!"



"I'll swap you," Bonnie said sweetly. "Five flowers for five tickets. O.K.?"



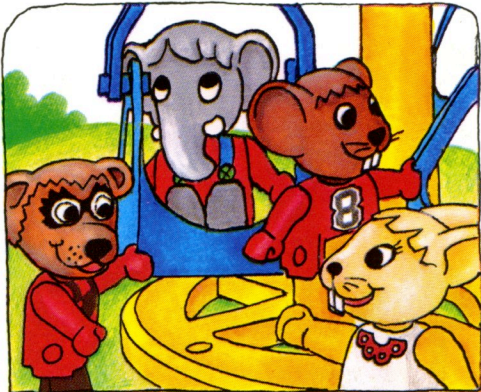
"That's a ride for the three of us. And two extra. How shall we decide who gets the extras?" Bonnie asked.

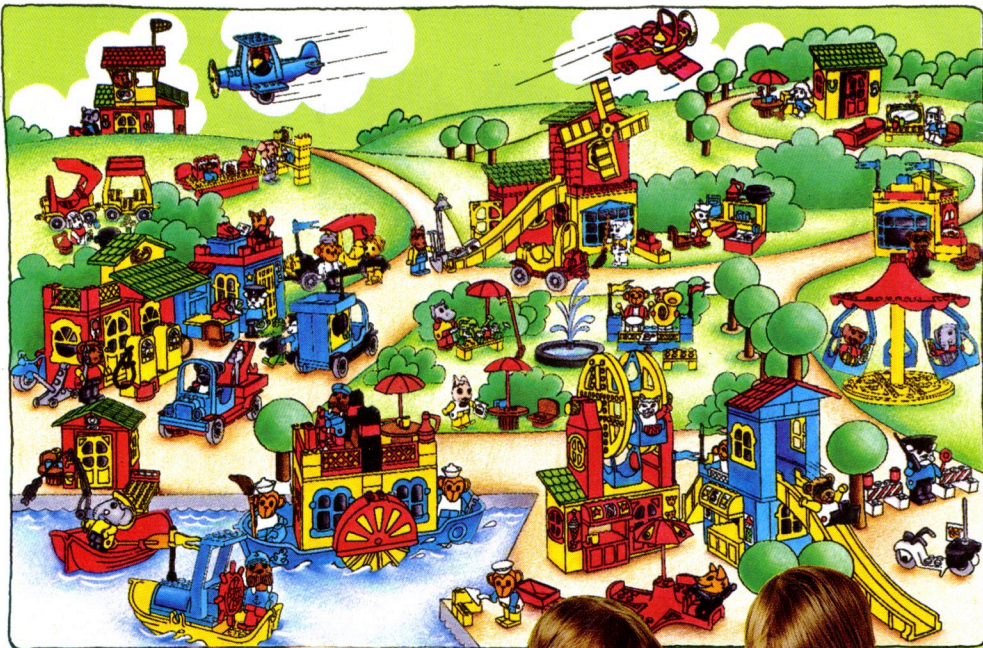
