




Max Mouse loves to try new things.



Edward Elephant is a worrier. He's afraid the merry-go-round isn't strong enough to hold a big elephant.




























The following pages teatures a small FABULAND® story which may show figures and buildings not included in the box.

"Fantastic," Edward agreed, reaching for another piece of cake.




Max Mouse joined them. "Don't eat so much if you're going on the merry-go-round. You could get sick."
